Dear Residents,

As public spaces throughout the Twin Cities begin to open, we have considered the pros and cons of opening the playgrounds on our properties. After much consideration, we have decided to reopen the playgrounds on Wednesday, July 17<sup>th</sup>. Please note that we will not be disinfecting the playgrounds and use of them should be done with your own discretion. We recommend that if you or your family decides to use the playgrounds, that social distancing is still practiced to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

The CDC has also recommended the following prevention measures:

- Wash hands often with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds. If soap and water are unavailable, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue away.
- Frequently clean and disinfect touched objects and surfaces.

We will continue to follow developments regarding COVID-19 and retain the right to reverse this decision if the necessity to do so presents itself.
