



## COVID-19 Maintenance Protocol:

- 1) While maintenance is in your unit, remain in another room or a minimum of 6 feet away. If this is not being done, maintenance has the right to leave your unit.
- 2) Once finished, the tech will leave your unit and knock, so you know you can come back out. The tech can explain the repair that was done from outside your unit.

## Strategies to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- 1) Wash your hands frequently, especially whenever you have come into contact with something outside of your unit.
- 2) Maintain social distancing. Stay at least six feet away from anyone that is coughing or sneezing. This helps prevent yourself from breathing in droplets that the other person has expelled.
- 3) Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth. Because your hands come into contact with so many surfaces, they are more likely to pick something up. You don't want the things they have picked up to enter into your body through your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- 4) Practice respiratory hygiene. When you sneeze or cough, do so into a tissue or your bent elbow. If you use a tissue, immediately place it into the garbage.
