# Pay your rent, keep your housing

**Landlords will begin to evict tenants who have not paid their rent once the eviction suspension order is lifted**

## **We want you to keep your housing**

The best way to ensure that you can stay in your home is to keep paying your rent or as much of it as you can. Once the eviction suspension order is lifted, your landlord will require you to pay any rent you have missed. It may be difficult to pay for a number of months at once. If you are not able to pay, you will be evicted.

## **How to keep your housing**

**Step one:** Pay as much as you can toward your rent each month.  
If you receive a stimulus check, use it to pay your rent.

**Step two:** Call your landlord. Explain your situation. Call mediation at 651-370-2529 if you need help talking to your landlord.

**Step three:** If you're struggling to cover the cost of your rent, contact Ramsey County Emergency Assistance or Neighborhood House for help.
